

ITINERARY FOR ULTIMATE SAFARI



This three-week Ultimate Safari takes in the very best safari sights of Botswana, Tanzania and gorilla trekking in Rwanda.

- Okavango Delta Botswana
- Zanzibar, Ngorongoro Crater & Serengeti Tanzania
- Gorilla Trekking Rwanda

Day 1 Overnight SEBA CAMP, BOTSWANA

Fly from Johannesburg to Maun, Botswana. On arrival at Maun Airport you will be assisted by a Wilderness Safaris representative to your light aircraft for a short air transfer to Seba Camp in the Okavango Delta. Flying over the Delta gives you a wonderful overview of this precious wilderness. Seba Camp overlooks a perennial lagoon with prolific birdlife and resident hippo, plus regular leopard sightings. It's an intimate tented camp with magnificent vistas — a wonderful first night in the wilds of Africa!

Day 2, 3 & 4 Overnight SEBA CAMP, BOTSWANA

Why not book a private vehicle for some of your time in this part of the Okavango Delta, where activities include mokoro canoe trips, game drives, night drives, fishing, nature walks and kids activities. It's a fully inclusive rate of accommodation, all meals, twice daily scheduled camp activities, park fees, laundry and all local drinks.

Day 5, 6 & 7 Overnight XIGERA CAMP, BOTSWANA

Game Drive transfer to the airstrip for your short flight in a small plane from Seba Camp to Xigera Camp. Xigera lies in the remote heart of the Okavango on Paradise Island, surrounded by deep channels and lush vegetation. This true wetland is a delight for birdwatchers and lovers of tranquil beauty and is the best place to see elusive sitatunga antelope. Meals and evening drinks are enjoyed in the lounge, bar and dining area overlooking a permanently flowing channel or under the stars in a traditional African boma. Fully inclusive.

Day 8 Overnight CITY LODGE, JOHANNESBURG, SOUTH AFRICA

At around 11h00, you'll board your last flight out of the Okavango to Kasane Airport to connect with a flight to Johannesburg, where you will stay one night in the City Lodge on bed & breakfast basis. Get a good night's sleep as it's an early morning flight to Zanzibar the next day!

Day 9 Lunch in ZANZIBAR, Overnight AFRICAN TULIP HOTEL, ARUSHA, TANZANIA

Board an early flight to the spice island of Zanzibar, where you'll have lunch at the Serena Inn on the sea-front of ancient Stone Town, flanked by an exotic mix of sultan's palaces, Portuguese forts, ancient dhows and bright bazaars. This is just a taster of Zanzibar before you return to the airport for the short flight to Arusha. You'll be met and transferred to the African Tulip Hotel in Arusha in readiness for tomorrow's drive to Lake Natron.

Day 10 & 11 Overnight LAKE NATRON CAMP, TANZANIA

Depart with your private guide in a 4X4 vehicle for a full day scenic drive on gravel roads to Lake Natron Camp. Located within walking distance are ancient hominid footprints and Lake Natron where over 1 million flamingos come to breed. This tented camp is also ideally situated for a number of activities and expeditions.

Day 12 Overnight NGORONGORO FARMHOUSE, TANZANIA

After breakfast depart for the scenic drive of approximately 4 hours to Ngorongoro Farmhouse. This is a small and exclusive lodge facing the Oldeani Volcano, only 5 km from a gate leading into the Ngorongoro Crater. It's a working farm reminiscent of the atmosphere of the old days.

Day 13, 14 & 15 Overnight NDUTU WILDERNESS CAMP, TANZANIA

After breakfast drive down into the famous Ngorongoro Caldera and spend the day game viewing in one of the most spectacular places on earth! Photographic opportunities are abundant, and you often see four of the Big Five in a short time. Have a picnic lunch in the crater floor at a pleasant lakeside location, where you can stretch your legs and soak up the magnificent scenery.

Afternoon drive to Ndutu Wilderness Camp in the Ngorongoro Conservancy. This is an atmospheric and intimate tented camp where you can take advantage of the optional activities during you full days in the Ngorongoro Conservancy. Full board includes all snacks, activities, bottled mineral water, coffee and tea available throughout the day.

Day 16 & 17 Overnight SERENGETI WILDERNESS CAMP, TANZANIA

Drive through the Serengeti to the Serengeti Wilderness Camp. With just ten spacious tents, this seasonal camp has the benefit of being able to move to some of the best game viewing areas every three to six, making it a truly eco-friendly camp. You can choose from walking, driving, birding and hot air ballooning (if pre-booked).

Day 18 Overnight KIGALI SERENA HOTEL, RWANDA

Morning activities at Serengeti Wilderness Camp. Afternoon transfer to airstrip for flight to Kigali, Rwanda. You will be met in Kigali and transferred to Kigali Serena Hotel on a dinner, bed and breakfast basis. Kigali is the fastest growing city in Africa and buzzing with life and this hotel will give you a touch of Kigali life.

Day 19 Overnight SABYINYO SILVERBACK LODGE, RWANDA

At 09h00 your guide will drive you to the Twin Lakes with lunch at Virunga Lodge. Then onto Sabyinyo Silverback Lodge in readiness for your first exciting gorilla trek. This lodge is located close to the headquarters of the Parc National des Volcans, from where you will trek on foot tomorrow to see the magnificent Mountain Gorillas - one of the most dramatic and thrilling wildlife experiences on earth. Full board plus two gorilla permits per person.

Day 19 Overnight SABYINYO SILVERBACK LODGE, RWANDA

Excitement levels are high for this "bucket list" experience where you get to meet rare and endangered Mountain Gorillas in their natural habitat.

Day 20 Overnight SABYINYO SILVERBACK LODGE, RWANDA

Today is your second chance to see the gorillas – an experience you will remember for the rest of your life.

Day 21 End of Safari

Sorry, but it's time to leave Africa, with a flight from Kigali to Kilimanjaro Airport then a connecting flight to Europe and onto USA.
